## **HANSEMAN SEEKING COURT OF APPEALS SEAT**

**DAYTON, OH** - Robert Hanseman announced today that he will seek a seat on the 2<sup>nd</sup> District Court of Appeals that will become vacant after the retirement of Judge Jeffrey Welbaum. Hanseman will seek the Republican nomination in the March 19<sup>th</sup> primary.

I believe in our system of government, including our most basic freedoms contained in the Bill of Rights, and will uphold both the federal and Ohio constitutions” said Hanseman.
